

49 countries have achieved this




The year China was supposed to have a complete ban on smoking in workplaces and public places under the FCTC


Number of cities with a comprehensive SF law that meets Article 8 guidelines

#### How does smoking in China compare to other ITC countries? In 2013-2015:








highest % among 20 countries
